## Behaviour Plan for Maple Class and Silver Birch Class (YR)

### The rules in our classroom are:

- We tidy up
- We share
- We listen
- We put our hands up
- We are kind to each other

### When we behave well in our class:

- Our teacher is pleased with us and our name is put on the board under a smiley face
- We get a sticker at the end of a session
- We might get a "scale" in our Celebration Assembly on Fridays
- We might get a sticker at lunchtime from the supervisory assistants
- We might get a Headteacher's award
- We might get a treat on Friday
- We might get to take the class teddy home

### When our class behaves well we get:

- A star to be put on our class reward chart and we get 'treat time'

### When we do not behave in class:

- Our teacher is not pleased with us and explains why
- We get moved to sit on our own
- We get asked to draw a picture of ourselves playing nicely
- Our choice of activity is limited by our teacher during choosing times
- Our name is put on the board under a sad face for half a day
- If we continue to misbehave a tick is put by our name
- If we have two ticks by our name in half a day or it is particularly serious we lose some of our playtime
- Our parents are asked to talk to Mrs Whiteley or Miss Matier
- We lose playtimes over a longer period

### In the playground we are:

- Spoke to by the Duty Teacher or Supervisory Assistant
- Have to stay with a grown up
- Spoken to by Mrs Whiteley or Miss Matier
- Lose some of our playtime

### If we still choose not to behave or behave very badly:

- Mrs Whiteley or Miss Matier will ask to see our parents
- We may be sent to Miss Holland (Deputy Headteacher)
- We may be sent to the Headteacher, Mrs Moore
- Our parents are informed and seen by Mrs Moore
- A Home-School behaviour programme is begun so that our parents are aware of what is happening at school each day
